MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Larry Perkins appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Bangor, *Gunther J.*) following his conviction of violating a protective order, 19-A M.R.S.A. § 4011(1)(A) (Supp. 2000). Contrary to Perkins's contentions, viewing the evidence in a light most favorable to the State, there was sufficient evidence on which the court could base its finding that the State proved every element of the offense charged beyond a reasonable doubt, *State v. Turner*, 2001 ME 44, ¶ 6, 766 A.2d 1025, 1027; the court neither erred nor acted outside its discretion in excluding evidence of prior accusations that a State's witness had made against Perkins, *State v. Stanley*, 2000 ME 22, ¶ 8, 745 A.2d 981, 985; the fine of \$1500 imposed by the court on Perkins case was within the authority of the court to impose, *State v. Hudson*, 470 A.2d 786, 787 (Me. 1984).
