MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Kevin Grant appeals from a judgment of conviction of assault, 17-A M.R.S.A. § 207(1) (2000), entered in the District Court (Machias, *Romei, J.*). Contrary to Grant's contentions, when viewed in a light most favorable to the State, *State v. Turner*, 2001 ME 44, ¶ 6, 766 A.2d 1025, 1027, the evidence supports the court's conclusion that the State proved the elements of assault beyond a reasonable doubt. *State v. Philbrick*, 551 A.2d 847, 852 (Me. 1988).
