MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father appeals from the judgment entered in the District Court (Houlton, *Griffiths, J.*) finding that Patrick C. is in circumstances of jeopardy to his health or welfare. Contrary to the father's contentions, the evidence of the father's substance abuse, the parents' physical abuse of Patrick's siblings, Patrick's inability to sleep without medication, and his untoward aggressive behavior are sufficient to support the court's jeopardy finding. 22 M.R.S.A. § 4002(6) and (10) (1992). The father's contentions that the court erred in curtailing his cross-examination of a witness and in denying his motion for approval of a subpoena seeking discovery are without merit.
