MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Claude Hall appeals from the judgment of conviction entered in the Superior Court (Waldo County, *Marsano, J.*) on a jury verdict finding him guilty of (1) operating after suspension (Class E) in violation of 29-A M.R.S.A. § 2412-A (1996 & Supp. 2000) and (2) operating an unregistered motor vehicle (Class E) in violation of 29-A M.R.S.A. § 351 (Supp. 2000). Contrary to Hall's contentions, the statutes under which he was convicted do not violate his constitutional right to travel. *See State v. Demeritt*, 149 Me. 380, 383-84, 103 A.2d 106, 108 (Me. 1953).
