MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother appeals from the judgment entered in the District Court (Ellsworth, *Staples, J.*) terminating her parental rights in her son Dustin W. On appeal the mother challenges the sufficiency of the evidence underlying the court's determination that she was unable to protect Dustin from jeopardy, that she was unable to take responsibility for Dustin in a time reasonably calculated to meet his needs, and that the termination of her parental rights was in Dustin's best interests. Contrary to her contentions, we conclude that the trial court reasonably could have been persuaded that its factual findings were highly probable. *See, e.g., In re Marcus D.*, 583 A.2d 701 (Me. 1990).
