MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Carol Peaslee appeals from the judgment entered in the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Studstrup, J.*) affirming the judgment entered in the District Court (Augusta, *Anderson, J.*) after a conditional plea of guilty to the charge of receiving stolen property in violation of 17-A M.R.S.A. § 359 (1983) (Class E). Contrary to Peaslee's contentions, the District Court did not err by denying her motion to suppress. *State v. Thibodeau*, 2000 ME 52, ¶ 5, 747 A.2d 596, 598. The consent to enter her residence was not induced by deceit, trickery, or misrepresentation. *State v. Barlow*, 320 A.2d 895, 900 (Me. 1974).
