MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Dexter Berry appeals the judgment of the Superior Court (Oxford County, *Bradford, A.R.J.*) affirming the judgment of the District Court (Rumford, *Mullen, J.*) granting Gloria Berry's motion to enforce. Contrary to Dexter's assertions, by signing the amended qualified domestic relations order entitling Gloria to three-fourths of Dexter's monthly pension distribution for a limited period of time, the court was not modifying the division of marital property, but was acting to enforce the provisions of the divorce judgment. *See Booth v. Booth*, 640 A.2d 1063, 1065 (Me. 1994) (holding that enforcement order requiring installment payments was not a modification of divorce judgment).
