MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Colleen Savage appeals from the judgment of the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Mills*, *J.*) affirming the judgment of the District Court (Augusta, *Field*, *J.*) finding her guilty of operating under the influence of intoxicating liquor. Contrary to Savage's contentions, the District Court did not exceed the bounds of its discretion when it denied her motion for continuance of trial. *See State v. Reed*, 479 A.2d 1291, 1295 (Me. 1984).
