MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Nasrin Hilmi appeals a judgment entered in the District Court (Bangor, *Gunther, J.*) granting Khalil Jassem's motion to modify the parties' existing divorce judgment. Contrary to Hilmi's contentions, the District Court did not exceed the bounds of its discretion in (1) modifying the divorce judgment with respect to child support and visitation, and (2) refraining from addressing spousal support, social security/retirement benefits, and the tax dependency of the minor children. *See Rowland v. Kingman*, 629 A.2d 613, 616 (Me. 1993). Nor did the court err in failing to modify its previous orders as to child support, because Hilmi failed to move for a modification of support under 19-A M.R.S.A. § 2009. Finally, no evidence exists in the record to support Hilmi's claim that the court's

rulings and Order were biased or prejudicial. *See In re William S.*, 2000 ME 34, ¶ 8, 745 A.2d 991, 995.
