MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Joseph Covillion appeals from the judgment of conviction entered in the Superior Court (Somerset County, *Studstrup, J.*) following a jury verdict finding him guilty of one count of violating an order for protection (Class D) in violation of 17-A M.R.S.A. § 506-B(3) (Supp. 2001). Contrary to Covillion's contentions, the evidence was sufficient to support his conviction because the jury "rationally could have found beyond a reasonable doubt every element of the offense charged." *State v. Turner*, 2001 ME 44, ¶ 6, 766 A.2d 1025, 1027.
