## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Brian Amero appeals from a divorce judgment entered in District Court (Presque Isle, *Griffiths*, *J*.) that, inter alia, divided the parties' marital property and awarded spousal support to Lisa Dubay. Contrary to Amero's contentions, (1) the court did not abuse its discretion in denying his motion for findings of fact and conclusions of law, *see Peters v. Peters*, 1997 ME 134, ¶ 12, 697 A.2d 1254, 1258; (2) the court was not required to make specific findings on each of the spousal support factors enumerated in 19-A M.R.S.A. § 951-A(5) (Supp. 2002), *see Shanoski v. Miller*, 2001 ME 139, ¶ 25, 780 A.2d 275, 280; and (3) the court did not abuse its discretion in the division of marital property and award of lump-sum

and nominal spousal support, *see Dargie v. Dargie*, 2001 ME 127, ¶¶ 4, 27, 778 A.2d 353, 355, 359.
