MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Marek Kwasnik appeals from a judgment entered in District Court (Portland, *Eggert*, *J.*) finding that he committed a traffic infraction by speeding on the Maine Turnpike (79 m.p.h. in a 55 m.p.h. zone). We must affirm the judgment, as we are unable to evaluate Kwasnik's argument that he was not driving at the speed found by the court because he has not provided us with a transcript or a statement of the evidence pursuant to M.R. App. P. 5(d). *Tenney v. Benson*, 1999 ME 177, ¶ 1, 741 A.2d 454, 455 (per curiam).
