MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Curtis Robinson appeals from a judgment entered in Superior Court (Hancock County, *Gorman, J.*), modifying and affirming a disclosure order of the District Court (Ellsworth, *Staples, J.*) in favor of his former attorney, Roger Innes. Contrary to Robinson's contentions, the District Court did not abuse its discretion to control the presentation of evidence, *see* M.R. Evid. 611(a); *Dolliver v. Dolliver*, 2001 ME 144, ¶ 10, 782 A.2d 316, 317; did not err in granting Innes an assignment of funds due to Robinson from his ex-wife; and did not clearly err in finding implicitly that Robinson owned the personal property awarded to him in a recent divorce judgment and listed on an exhibit that Robinson had filed with the divorce court, *see* M.R. Civ. P. 52(a); 14 M.R.S.A. § 3131(1), (2) (Supp. 2001) (authorizing turnover and sale of property owned by debtor).
