MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Delmar Newenham appeals from the judgment of conviction for assault (Class D), 17-A M.R.S.A. § 207 (1983 & Supp. 2001), entered in the Superior Court (Washington County, *Humphrey, J.*) following a jury trial. Contrary to Newenham's contention, the evidence, when viewed in the light most favorable to the State, is sufficient to support his conviction. *State v. Turner*, 2001 ME 44, ¶ 6, 766 A.2d 1025, 1027.
