MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Jorjiana and Andreana appeals from the District Court's (Rockland, *Anderson, J.*) termination of her parental rights. Contrary to her contention, the court did not violate her due process rights by denying her request for psychological evaluations of herself and the children when she failed to attend the hearing and waited until the day of the hearing to request an indefinite delay for independent psychological evaluations. 22 M.R.S.A. § 4007(3) (1992); M.R. Civ. P. 35. *Compare with In re Joseph C.*, 1997 ME 143, 696 A.2d 1098 (court deprived the mother of due process when she moved for appointment of an independent expert within a reasonable time and the court refused to keep the record open for "modest and reasonable" amount of time).
