MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Jason E. appeals from the judgment entered in the District Court (Bangor, *Russell, J.*) terminating her parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(b)(i) (1992). Contrary to the mother's assertions, there is sufficient evidence in the record to support the court's finding that she is unable to protect Jason from jeopardy, that she is unlikely to be able to do so within a time reasonably likely to meet Jason's needs, and that the termination of her parental rights is in Jason's best interest.
