MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Edgar Roberts appeals from a judgment of conviction of unlawful trafficking in scheduled drugs (Class C), 17-A M.R.S.A. § 1103(1), (2)(B) (Supp. 2001), and criminal forfeiture, 15 M.R.S.A. § 5826(1) (Supp. 2001), entered in the Superior Court (Androscoggin County, *Gorman J.*) following Roberts's conditional guilty plea after the denial of his motion to suppress. Roberts argues that the court erred when it denied his motion to suppress items seized in a search of his residence. The evidence supports the court's finding that there was a substantial basis for the warrant judge's determination that there was probable cause to search Roberts's home. *See State v. Haley*, 571 A.2d 831, 832 (Me. 1990); *State v. Knowlton*, 489 A.2d 529, 532-33 (Me. 1985).
