MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Shadrach Brown appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Bangor) after Brown failed to object to the Case Management Officer's decision (*Jordan*, CMO) granting the Department of Human Services's motion to modify his child support obligations. Contrary to Brown's contention, the evidence was sufficient to support the child support modification. *See State v. Nugent*, 2002 ME 111, ¶ 2, 801 A.2d 1001, 1002 ("When the record on appeal does not include a transcript of the proceedings below, we must assume that the transcript would

support the trial court's findings of fact and its rulings on evidence and procedure.").
