MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Dean McEwen appeals from an order of the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Marden, J.*) dismissing his petition for judicial review of a determination by the Department of Human Services that he had abused or neglected a child. Because McEwen filed his notice of appeal beyond the twenty-one day period established by M.R. App. P. 2(b)(3), and failed to make a showing of excusable neglect as required by M.R. App. P. 2(b)(5), we dismiss his appeal as untimely. *Bourke v. City of S. Portland*, 2002 ME 155, ¶ 4, 806 A.2d 1255, 1256.
