MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Anthony Godfrey appeals from a judgment of conviction of theft by unauthorized taking or transfer (Class C), 17-A M.R.S.A. §§ 353, 362(3)(A) (1983 & Supp. 2000), entered after a jury trial in Superior Court (Penobscot County, *Hunter, J.*). The court (*Mead, J.*) did not err in denying Godfrey's motion to suppress his confessions. The evidence at the suppression hearing supports the court's implicit finding that Godfrey's confessions were voluntary because they were not induced by a promise of leniency. *See State v. Hutchinson*, 597 A.2d 1344, 1346 (Me. 1991); *State v. Theriault*, 425 A.2d 986, 990 (Me. 1981).
