MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Henry J., Jr., Sabrina A., Albert A., and Christopher A. appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Lewiston, *Beliveau*, *J*.) terminating her parental rights to all four children. Contrary to the mother's contentions, there is sufficient evidence in the record to support the District Court's findings by clear and convincing evidence that she is unwilling or unable to protect the children from jeopardy, and that those circumstances are unlikely to change within a time reasonably calculated to meet the children's needs, *see* 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(b)(i) (1992), that she has not made a good faith effort to rehabilitate and reunify with her children, *see id*. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(b)(iv), and that termination of her parental rights is in the children's best interests, *see id*. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a). Finally, contrary to the mother's contention, the court did not

clearly err by giving too much weight to the infant mental health assessment. *See In re Rachel J.*, 2002 ME 148, ¶ 20, 804 A.2d 418, 424-25.
