MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Disappointed bidder MEP Management Services, Inc., appeals from a decision of the Public Utilities Commission declining to overturn a contract award to L.K. Goldfarb Associates for an interim small business energy conservation program. *See* An Act to Strengthen Energy Conservation, P.L. 2001, ch. 624(7). Contrary to MEP's contentions, neither the PUC's bidding procedures nor the award of the contract to Goldfarb was arbitrary and capricious, an abuse of discretion, fundamentally unfair, or otherwise unlawful. *See Pine Tree Legal Assistance, Inc. v. Dep't of Human Servs.*, 655 A.2d 1260, 1264 (Me. 1995).
