MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Frederick Krause appeals from a judgment entered in District Court (Lewiston, *Eggert, J.*) modifying the parties' original divorce judgment. Contrary to Frederick's contentions, the evidence on the record supports the trial court's factual findings, *see Town of Stonington v. Galilean Gospel Temple*, 1999 ME 2, ¶ 19, 722 A.2d 1269, 1273; and the trial court did not abuse its discretion in not appointing a guardian ad litem, excluding hearsay evidence, or quashing the witness subpoenas. *See Coppersmith v. Coppersmith*, 2001 ME 165, ¶ 4, 786 A.2d 602, 604; *State v. Tomah*, 1999 ME 109, ¶ 7, 736 A.2d 1047, 1050; *State v. Watson*, 1999 ME 41, ¶ 7, 726 A.2d 214, 216.

Frederick has no standing to assert his children's constitutional rights in this appeal. See State v. York, 1997 ME 209, \P 5, 704 A.2d 324, 325.
