## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Kyle T. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Waterville, *Vafiades, C.J.*) terminating her parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (1992). Contrary to the mother's contentions, the record supports the court's findings, by clear and convincing evidence, that there is at least one ground of parental unfitness, *see In re Michaela C.*, 2002 ME 159, ¶ 17, 809 A.2d 1245, 1250, and termination of the mother's parental rights is in the child's best interest, *see In re Jeremiah Y.*, 2002 ME 135, ¶ 9, 804 A.2d 357, 359.
