MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Christian J. Mullen appeals from the paternity and parental rights judgment of the District Court (Portland, *Beaudoin, J.*), finding Mullen to be the father of the child, awarding sole parental rights and responsibilities to Julie A. Andrews, and not making any order of child support. Mullen contests the sole parental rights determination and as his “reason for appeal” states: “I have additional testimony to present and a witness to bring forward.” Mullen has not supported his appeal with a transcript of the proceedings, and he does not suggest that any of the court’s fact-

findings are error. No error is indicated in the available record. *See Alley v. Alley*, 2002 ME 162, ¶ 2, 809 A.2d 1262, 1262.
