MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Eric Sloatman appeals from a judgment entered in District Court (Rockland, *Worth, J.*) adjudicating him to have committed the traffic infraction of failure to stop at a stop sign, 29-A M.R.S.A. § 2057(7) (1996). Because Sloatman has not provided us with a transcript of the trial or a statement of the evidence pursuant to M.R. App. P. 5(d), we are unable to evaluate his argument that the court improperly refused to allow him to present his defense, and we must assume that the court did not abuse its discretion in the way it conducted the trial. *See State v. Nugent*, 2002 ME 111, ¶ 2, 801 A.2d 1001, 1002.
