MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Betty Cameron appeals from an order entered in Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Marden, J.*) denying Cameron's motion for a new trial following a jury verdict and judgment for Kupfer. Contrary to Cameron's contention, the evidence, viewed in the light most favorable to Kupfer, credibly supports the jury's finding that Kupfer was not negligent and/or that such negligence was not a proximate cause of Cameron's injury. *Poirier v. Hayes*, 466 A.2d 1261, 1263 n.1 (Me. 1983). Furthermore, the trial court's denial of Cameron's motion for a new trial was not a clear and manifest abuse of discretion. *Binette v. Deane*, 391 A.2d 811, 813 (Me. 1978).
