MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

William Fairley appeals from the judgment entered by the Superior Court (Hancock County, *Mead*, *J*.) accepting the referee's amended order on remand, which granted Francis Hennessy a significant percentage of the land that is the subject of this action. In *Hennessy v. Fairley*, 2002 ME 76, 796 A.2d 41, we vacated the Superior Court's (*Marsano*, *J*.) rejection of the referee's findings, but remanded the case for clarification of the boundary. *Id.* ¶ 28, 796 A.2d at 49. On remand, the referee adjusted the boundary line to provide the clarification requested in our remand. Contrary to Fairley's contentions, the boundary line

findings, as clarified, are supported by competent evidence and do not reflect any error of law.
