MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Harry J. Smith Jr. appeals from a judgment entered after a jury trial in the Superior Court (Washington County, *Hunter*, *J*.) convicting him of illegal handling of hazardous waste (Class C), 38 M.R.S.A. § 1319-T(1)(C) (2001); and establishing, constructing, altering, or operating a waste facility without a proper license or permit (Class D), 38 M.R.S.A. § 1319-T(2)(A) (2001). Contrary to Smith's contentions, the evidence, when viewed in the light most favorable to the State, was sufficient for the jury to find each element of the offenses beyond a

reasonable doubt. *See State v. Barnard*, 2003 ME 79, ¶ 20, 828 A.2d 216, 222 (citations omitted).
