MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Chad Emery appeals from a District Court (Newport, *Murray, J.*) judgment finding him guilty on two counts of assault (Class D) pursuant to 17-A M.R.S.A. § 207(1)(A) (Supp. 2002). Contrary to Emery's contention, the District Court had sufficient evidence to find him guilty of the crimes charged. *See State v. Turner*, 2001 ME 44, ¶ 6, 766 A.2d 1025, 1027.
