MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of Matthew G. appeals from the judgment entered in the District Court (Farmington, *Mullen, J.*) terminating his parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (1992). Contrary to the father's contentions, the record supports the court's findings, by clear and convincing evidence, of parental unfitness, *see In re Alana S.*, 2002 ME 126, ¶ 20, 802 A.2d 976, 981, and that termination of parental rights is in Matthew's best interest, *see In re Jeremiah Y.*, 2002 ME 135, ¶ 9, 804 A.2d 357, 359.
