MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Carol Connolly appeals from a judgment entered in the Superior Court (Penobscot County, *Mead, J.*) affirming the decision of the Board of Social Worker Licensure, imposing sanctions on her for violating Board Rules Chapter 5, § 3(C)(7), (11) (May 28, 1997) for improperly revealing confidential client information. Contrary to Connolly's contention, the Board did not abuse its discretion in imposing sanctions pursuant to 10 M.R.S.A. § 8003(5)(A-1)(3)-(4) (Supp. 2002). *See Davric Me. Corp. v. Me. Harness Racing Comm'n*, 1999 ME 99, ¶ 7, 732 A.2d 289, 293.
