MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Adrian S. Poland appeals from a judgment of conviction of operating under the influence (Class D), 29-A M.R.S.A. § 2411(1) (1996), entered after a jury trial in the Superior Court (Lincoln County, *Studstrup, J.*). Contrary to Poland's contention, the evidence, when viewed in the light most favorable to the State, was sufficient for a fact-finder to rationally find each element of the offense beyond a reasonable doubt. *See State v. Melanson*, 2002 ME 145, ¶ 9, 804 A.2d 394, 397.
