#### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Katelynn M. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Biddeford, *Janelle*, *J*.) terminating her parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (1992). Contrary to the mother's contentions, the record supports the court's findings by clear and convincing evidence of at least one ground of parental unfitness, *see In re Alana S.*, 2002 ME 126, ¶ 20, 802 A.2d 976, 981, and that termination of her parental rights is in the children's best interests, *see In re Denise M.*, 670 A.2d 390, 392 (Me. 1996).
