MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Shirley Taylor and Beverly A. Bromfield appeal from an order entered in the Cumberland County Probate Court (*Childs, J.*) instructing the estate's personal representative to make a per capita at each generation distribution of the Newell estate. Contrary to the appellants' contention, the Probate Court did not err in determining that Newell's will did not indicate an intent contrary to 18-A M.R.S.A. § 2-611 (1998); therefore, the Probate Court did not err when it ordered a distribution per capita at each generation.
