MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Alfred Gallant appeals from an order entered in Superior Court (Oxford County, *Humphrey, J.*) denying his motion to terminate his probation and terminate a condition of his probation requiring him to receive case management services. Because Gallant has not provided us with a transcript of the hearing in Superior Court, we must assume that the court's refusal to terminate or modify Gallant's probation pursuant to 17-A M.R.S.A. § 1202(2), (3) (Supp. 2002) was supported by the evidence and was not an abuse of discretion. *See State v. Nugent*, 2002 ME 111, ¶ 2, 801 A.2d 1001, 1002.
