MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Jennifer Wright appeals from a judgment entered in the Superior Court (Knox County, *Jabar, J.*) finding her guilty of obstructing government administration (Class D), 17-A M.R.S.A. § 751(1) (1983 & Supp. 2002). Contrary to Wright's contentions, the court did not err when it declined to give a proposed jury instruction on the issue of defense of a third person, *see* 17-A M.R.S.A. § 108(1-A) (Supp. 2002) (no justification available against law enforcement official attempting to effect an arrest or detention); *State v. Dumond*, 2000 ME 95,

¶ 12, 751 A.2d 1014, 1018, and competent evidence in the record supports her conviction, *see State v. McCurdy*, 2002 ME 66, ¶ 10, 795 A.2d 84, 88.
