MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Susan Wright appeals from an order entered in the District Court (Portland, *Powers, J.*) denying her motion for enlargement of time within which to file a demand for a jury trial. Because Wright would not irreparably lose substantial rights by awaiting final judgment, and this appeal does not qualify for any of the other exceptions to the final judgment rule, her interlocutory appeal must be dismissed. *State v. Curtis*, 1998 ME 254, ¶¶ 4-5, 721 A.2d 175, 176.
