MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Roger Wheelock appeals from a summary judgment entered in the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Marden, J.*) awarding SCI Systems, Inc., \$148,452 and costs of suit with interest. Contrary to Wheelock's contention, the court did not err when it determined that there was no genuine issue as to Wheelock's obligation to pay a total of \$152,000 in restitution to SCI Systems, Inc., as a result of his federal criminal conviction. *Levine v. R.B.K. Caly Corp.*, 2001 ME 77, ¶ 4, 770 A.2d 653, 655. Wheelock's remaining arguments are without merit.
