MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Marvin Jacobs appeals from a judgment of divorce entered in the District Court (Belfast, *Nivison, J.*). Specifically, he challenges the property division and debt allocation contained in the divorce decree. Contrary to Marvin's contentions, in the District Court's well-reasoned and thoughtful divorce judgment and post-judgment order on Marvin's motion for further findings of fact, the court did not abuse its discretion when it divided the marital property and allocated responsibility for the parties' debt, *see Libby v. Libby*, 2001 ME 130, ¶¶ 6-7, 781 A.2d 773, 775, and it did not clearly err when it found that the current assets of the

business were marital property, *see Doucette v. Washburn*, 2001 ME 38, ¶ 7, 766 A.2d 578, 581.
