MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother and father of Justin G., Jeremy G., and Joshua G. appeal from the judgment of the District Court (Farmington, *Mullen, J.*) terminating their parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (1992). Contrary to their contentions, the record supports the court's finding by clear and convincing evidence that neither parent is able to take responsibility for the children within a time reasonably calculated to meet the children's needs, *see In re Alana S.*, 2002 ME 126, ¶¶ 20, 23, 802 A.2d 976, 981, and that termination of parental rights is in each child's best interest, *see In re Jeremiah Y.*, 2002 ME 135, ¶ 9, 804 A.2d 357, 359.
