MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

James Christopher Blyler appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Biddeford, *Janelle, J.*) denying him an order of protection from abuse. App. P. 5(d), we must assume that the record fully supports the court's factual findings and discretionary choices. *See Rothstein v. Maloney*, 2002 ME 179, ¶ 11, 816 A.2d 812, 813.
