MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of Alexander C. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Calais, *Romei, J.*) terminating his parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2004). The father does not challenge the court's findings regarding parental unfitness, but does challenge the court's findings regarding the child's best interests. Contrary to the father's contentions, the record supports the court's findings by clear and convincing evidence that termination of his parental rights is in Alexander C.'s best interests. *See In re Alana S.*, 2002 ME 126, ¶ 10, 802 A.2d 976, 979.
