MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Alice Shaw appeals from a judgment entered in the Superior Court (Penobscot County, *Mead, J.*) in favor of Janet Robinson, Carol and Rae Jean Chamberlain. Contrary to Shaw's contentions, the court neither erred nor exceeded the bounds of its discretion when it held that she is not entitled to a declaratory judgment granting equitable title in certain real property held in the names of Carol and Rae Jean Chamberlain and by failing to award her betterments made to the Chamberlains' property while she resided thereon. *See Corey v. Corey*, 2002 ME 132, ¶ 10, 803 A.2d 1014, 1017; *Hennessy v. Fairley*, 2002 ME

76, ¶ 25, 796 A.2d 41, 49; *Paffhausen v. Balano*, 1998 ME 47, ¶ 6, 708 A.2d 269, 271; *State v. Kelly*, 606 A.2d 786, 788 (Me. 1992); and 14 M.R.S.A. § 6956 (2003).
