MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Darci R. Miller and John Miller each appeal from a divorce judgment of the District Court (Bangor, *Russell, J.*). Darci appeals (1) the decision upholding a premarital agreement the parties signed; (2) the failure to award transitional support; (3) the allocation of the tax exemption for the couple's child; (4) the allocation of health insurance costs for the child; (5) the property award; (6) the amount of child support ordered; (7) the visitation order; (8) the failure to sanction John for discovery violations; and (9) the response to Darci's request for additional factual findings and legal conclusions pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 52. John cross-

appeals (1) the calculation of John's income for child support purposes; (2) the grant of retroactive support; (3) the failure to credit certain home payments as child support; and (4) the award of attorney fees and costs. We find no legal error, abuse of discretion, or clearly erroneous factual findings in the divorce judgment. *See Doucette v. Washburn*, 2001 ME 38, ¶ 7, 776 A.2d 578, 581.
