MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Scotty Thyng appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (York County, *Brennan, J.*) affirming a judgment of the District Court (York, *Wheeler, J.*) dismissing, for lack of personal jurisdiction, his small claims action against the Greater Boston Association of Realtors and Joanne Manning, the director of that association. This matter arises out of an ethics complaint brought against a Massachusetts realtor, regarding a Massachusetts real estate transaction and dismissal of a grievance complaint by the Board of Directors of the Greater Boston Association of Realtors. Because the transactions at issue did not occur in Maine

and no defendant has any apparent connection with the State of Maine, the District Court correctly determined that it had no jurisdiction, under the small claims law, to hear this action. *See* 14 M.R.S.A. § 7483 (2003).
