MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Thomas M. Mangan appeals from a judgment entered by a Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court (*Clifford, J.*), denying Mangan's petition for a writ of mandamus to issue against the District Court (Lewiston, *McElwee, J.*), seeking to require the District Court to vacate a stay and enter judgment on Mangan's behalf in a pending contract action. Contrary to Mangan's contentions, he is not entitled to a writ of mandamus. *See Casco N. Bank v. Bd. of Trs. of Van Buren Hosp. Dist.*, 601 A.2d 1085, 1087 (Me. 1992).
