MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Richard Weatherbee appeals from an order entered in the District Court (Lincoln, *Stitham, J.*) denying his motion for relief from a divorce judgment pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 60(b)(6) and his subsequent motion to reconsider that denial. Contrary to Weatherbee's contention, the court did not exceed the bounds of its discretion in concluding that the motion for relief, filed more than a year after the divorce judgment, was not filed within a reasonable time pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 60(b)(6). *See Zink v. Zink*, 687 A.2d 229, 231 (Me. 1996).
