MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Erick M. Bennett appeals a judgment of conviction for assault (Class D), 17-A M.R.S.A. § 207(1)(A) (Supp. 2003), entered in the District Court (Bangor, *Griffiths, J.*) following a nonjury trial. Contrary to Bennett's contentions, the court did not commit clear error or abuse its discretion in excluding irrelevant evidence at trial, *see State v. Dechaine*, 572 A.2d 130, 133 (Me. 1990), and sufficient evidence does exist in the record to support his conviction, *see State v. Turner*, 2001 ME 44, ¶ 6, 766 A.2d 1025, 1027.
