MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Misty Pottle appeals from an order entered in the District Court (West Bath, *Field, J.*) denying Pottle's motion for contempt, and modifying her right to have contact with the parties' child. Pottle challenges the trial court's factual finding of "inappropriate parenting," as well as the court's decision to decrease her contact with the child. Because Pottle has not provided us with a transcript of the proceedings before the trial court or a statement of the evidence pursuant to M.R. App. P. 5(d), we must assume that there was sufficient evidence to support the trial court's factual findings. *Alley v. Alley*, 2002 ME 162, ¶ 2, 809 A.2d 1262, 1262.
